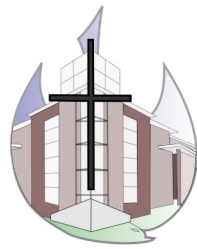


The Ascension of Our Lord (May 10th, 2018)

- 1. Preschool Registration** ~ Preschool Enrollment: Enrollment is open for the 2018-19 school year at Our Savior Lutheran Preschool. Mission speakers will include: Pastor Bob and Kristi Roegner with Apple of His Eye Mission Society which shares faith in Jesus with Jewish people (he is also national LWML Pastoral Counselor.); Pastor Gregory and Rachel Sonnenschein of Wind River Lutheran Mission at Ft.
