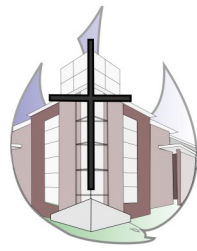

Beyond normal reports, they finalized plans for defibrillator training, approved the annual district pledge, made vacancy appointments to the Board of Education (Justin Tripp) and Board of Assimilation and Fellowship (Beth Geu). Church Thrivent Choice funds were approved to purchase replacement hymnals and also costumes for the Children's Christmas Program.
