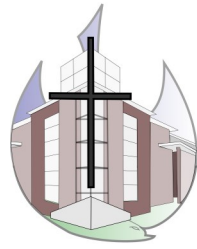

Africa Missions Presentation

Today, we will have a missions presentation. Rev. Timothy Rossow is here to show slides of his trips to Africa and to tell us about the work of Lutherans in Africa.

Lutherans in Africa is an independent LCMS mission group that is filling a great need in Africa. There are millions of Lutherans in Africa but they do not know what it means to be a Lutheran. Most Lutherans in Africa only see a pastor every other month. Many of those pastors have never read Luther's Small Catechism. Lutherans in Africa is translating the Small Catechism and other Lutheran materials into the local languages and is training both pastors and lay people to teach the Word of God to the millions of Lutherans in Africa.
