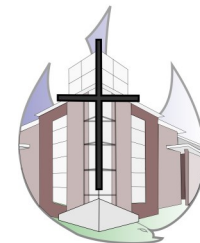

Congregational Announcements

1. **Mission Mite Minute:** Water and the Word for Rural Schools in Kenya - The children in Kenya struggle to have water in their schools and often walk miles each day to gather water that is not necessarily clean water. Children are not only drinking dirty water and getting sick, but falling behind in school because they spend so much of their day hauling water. This grant will help the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Kenya (ELCK) extend their ministry by expanding the clean water project (installing water harvesting equipment, filters, hand wash stations and clean water storage) to their schools and orphanages thereby building a relationship with ELCK as they provide sound biblical teachings in their sponsored schools. "O God, you are my God; earnestly I seek you; my soul thirsts for you; my flesh faints for you, as in a dry and weary land where there is no water." Psalm 63:1
