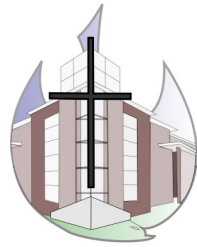

1. **LWML Fall Rally** ~ Ladies, you won't want to miss the LWML High Plains Zone 2019 Fall Rally Sunday, September 22, at Grace, Pine Bluffs. Rev. Timothy Schnare, representing the Lutheran Heritage Foundation, will be the guest speaker. At the 2013 and 2017 national conventions, LWML members voted to adopt two Lutheran Heritage Foundation (LHF) mission projects. Through your contributions to national LWML mission mites, you have assisted LHF in translating and printing thousands of Bible storybooks and Luther's Small Catechism for children and families around the world. Ditch the Sunday afternoon NFL and come be inspired by how the LHF is spreading the Gospel. Registration begins at 1:30pm and the \$5 registration fee covers the concluding meal.
2. **Church Picnic** ~ Please join us on Sunday, September 29th at 12:30 p.m. for our annual Church Picnic. 3. **Youth Night** ~ All youth 6th-12th grades are invited to our first Youth Night next Sunday, September 22, from 6-7:30 p.m. We will have pizza, Bible Study, and games. Our study this year is based on the book "Evolution: A Defense Against," by Rev. Lincoln Winter of Wheatland. For more information, talk to Pastor Baikie.
4. **Mission Mite Minute** - Lutheran Women's Missionary League (LWML) Grant #2 for the 2019-2021 biennium is Teach Me Too — Preschoolers with Learning Needs, Lutheran Special Education Ministries. This mission grant will provide funding for expanding the services of the Let It Shine Academy, which was designed to administer intervention strategies and address the unique needs of children with autism spectrum disorder in an early learning environment.
5. **Sunday Adult Bible Study - "Worship"**~ Ever wonder why we worship the way we do? Adult Bible study is covering the topic of worship, especially highlighting the reasons and Biblical foundation to the Lutheran liturgy.
