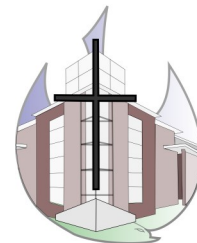

2. **Church Picnic** ~ Please join us TODAY, September 29<sup>th</sup> at 12:30 p.m. for our annual Church Picnic.
