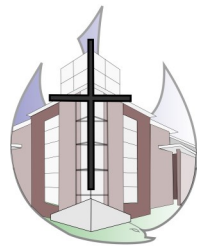

4. **Pray Without Ceasing** ~ Would you like to pray more and have a better daily devotional life? On Sunday, October 20 at 2pm Pastor Scheer will be teaching a one-hour class on daily prayer, especially teaching the use of the book "Treasury of Daily Prayer". A free copy of the volume will be given to those who attend if they don't have one already.
5. **Orphan Grain Train** ~ Fall is "clean out" time! We will be gathering items for Orphan Grain Train again until October 27th.
