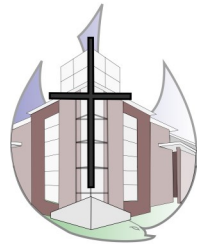

Congregational Announcements

1. **Financial Letter** ~ Packets were sent to our members last week detailing the current financial situation in our congregation. In it was a letter explaining both the problems that we are facing and the steps we are taking to correct them and an FAQ sheet about our Biblical understanding of giving. It was meant to give our members a clear picture of our congregation's finances and to help them make wise, Bible-based decisions about their household's giving. Sadly, the devil may use a challenging situation like this to tempt Christians to gossip, slander, hurt others' reputations, and put the worst construction on things. Therefore we would encourage you at this time (and always) to "encourage one another and build one another up" (1 Thessalonians 5:11) and, if you have an issue with someone's words or actions, to "be reconciled to your brother" (Matthew 5:24) by speaking to them personally.
