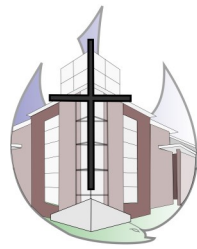

Congregational Announcements

1. **Ash Wednesday is February 26th** ~The holy season of Lent will begin at the end of the month. This year's devotion and midweek services will be going through the teaching of the Apostles' Creed to see how our Triune God loves us and cares for us in body and soul. What kind of God do we have? What has He done for us? Come and listen during these extra opportunities to hear the Word of the Lord. Ash Wednesday will have a Divine Service at 7pm. Midweek meals will begin on the first Wednesday of March.
2. **Youth Night** ~ All youth 6th-12th grades are invited to our next Youth Night on Sunday, February 23rd from 6-7:30 p.m. We will have pizza, Bible Study, and games. We are continuing our study of Evolution: A Defense Against by Pastor Lincoln Winter.
3. **Youth Night : Special Parents Night** ~ This month during our normal Youth night time (February 23rd, 6 pm), while the kids are learning and having fun we would like to have all parents of kids in our youth group (grades 6-12) attend a meeting with Pastor Scheer about how we as a congregation can help our families and kids faithfully handle the issues of our day (marriage issues, sexuality, etc.). Our children need a firm foundation to both live in this world but also to be not of the world. Let's work together to help our kids, as there is nothing more precious than the faith in Christ given to them at their baptism. We are working to provide childcare during that time so that all of our parents may attend.
4. **Lutheran Schools Week** ~ This week we are celebrating Lutheran Schools week at Our Savior Lutheran Preschool. Today during the Bible Study hour, Chris Hall, our director, will give a presentation on our preschool. During the week, the students will celebrate with a special presentation for their families, crafts, songs, and treats. We give thanks to God for our Lutheran school!
5. **Youth Choir** ~ Our youth are wonderful singers and we have decided to organize a youth choir! We would like to invite any youth, 4th-12th grade, to join us! We will be meeting before Youth Group each month. 4:45 - 5:45 p.m. It will be between confirmation and youth group. The date this month will be February 23rd.
