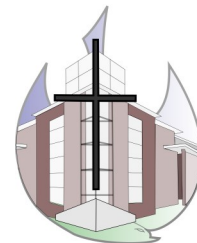

2. **LWML MEETING** ~ The LWML Meeting for March is today, March 8th at 1:30. All women of the congregation are welcome to attend.
3. **Lenten Bible School** ~ Every Wednesday during Lent between the meal and the service there will be a Bible story, crafts and a hymn for our youngest members.
4. **Lenten Midweek Services Begin** ~ Come to our Lenten Midweek Services as we reflect on the Apostles' Creed this year. Meals are at 5:45 pm and join us for Vespers at 7 pm. Our theme for this week in Lent is God the Son and the Humiliation. Join us as we observe our Lord's passion and resurrection! 5. **Swaddling Clothes** ~ Our next "Shopping Day" for families in our community to receive free clothes, diapers and formula is Saturday, March 14th from 11:00 am – 12:00 pm.
