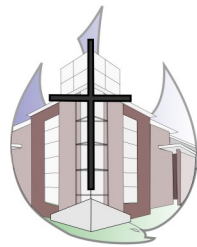
Communion Statement

Congregational Announcements

2. **Wednesday Bible Study @ 6pm** ~ Each Wednesday night we will be going through the lesson from the Psalms that is used the next Sunday. This will help us learn more about the Psalms, but also their use in our worship. The study of the Divine Service will continue when we restart Sunday morning Bible Study (likely in Fall). Join us Wednesdays at 6pm in the social hall. Zoom links will also be sent out while we have smaller limits on attendance.
3. **Children's Bible Study** - We will begin our Summer Children's Bible Study (Sunday School) on Wednesday, June 17, from 6 to 7 pm in the Narthex. It is open to all kids from preschool to 5th grade. We will use the usual Sunday School curriculum. For more information, or to volunteer to help, please speak to Pastor or Tiffany Baikie.
4. **Church Council Summary** - The Council met on Tuesday night. We heard normal reports, approved some financial approvals for our employees (Administrative Assistant and Preschool Director), approved a recommended gifts and memorials list for the congregation to consider at its next meeting (added a Radio Fund), began forming a nomination committee for Fall elections (Pastor Scheer and two voting members), approved two recommended missions for the congregation to consider for the next meeting (Siberian Seminary and Lutherans in Africa), and also approved funding from Thrivent Choice dollars to support expenses related to members attending Lander Camp in August.
5. **Vacation Bible School 2020** ~ This year's VBS is cancelled. Bible offerings for children this summer are in the works.
6. **Youth Camps 2020** ~ The governor of Colorado has forbidden overnight camps for the month of June and thus the Catechism Retreat is cancelled. The Wyoming District Youth Camp (Lander Camp) is still scheduled for August. Forms are on table in the Narthex. Please turn in to Pastor Baikie by July 12.
7. **Graduations celebrated:** The following members are celebrating graduations - Sydney Bell, Jake Geyer, Kristofer Munson, and Colby Siltzer who are all graduating from High School. Bailey Hamann is graduating from UW. The congregation is giving a gift copy of "Treasury of Daily Prayer" to each.
8. **We have openings for the Fall, 2020 Pre-kindergarten session** September to May. 5 Day AM classes, 4's and 5's (your child must be 4 on or before Sept. 15, 2020.) Sessions run 8:45 am to 11:45 am. Tuition (Our Savior member) \$300.00 monthly. Tuition (non member) 325.00 monthly. Military \$305.00. Enrollment Fee of \$80.00 is required to hold your spot.
