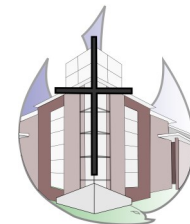

2. **Sunday School** - As of right now we are hoping to begin our new year of Sunday School on September 6th. Now is a good time to consider helping as a volunteer. Whether you love to spend time with the little ones or prefer to engage with our teenagers, there is always a need for teachers. If you are not comfortable teaching, we can always use classroom helpers as well. Please speak to Pastor Baikie if you are interested in helping with this wonderful task. Teacher Training will take place today, August 23rd at 1:00 pm. If you are teaching, please make every effort to attend this training, as we will discuss our plans for cleaning and spacing to keep our kids and teachers safe and healthy.
3. **Wednesday Bible Study @ 6 pm** ~ Join us Wednesdays at 6 pm in the social hall as we go through the lessons from the Psalms that is used the next Sunday. Zoom links will also be sent out. **Children's Bible Study** - Summer Children's Bible Study (Sunday School) meets on Wednesdays from 6 to 7 pm in the Narthex. It is open to all kids from preschool to 5th grade.
4. **Church Ice Cream Social** - Sunday, August 30th - After our 10:45 am service the congregation will gather (hopefully outside) to have a social time of ice cream treats. The Board of Education and the Board of Assimilation and Fellowship are putting plans together for this event in replacement of our normal church picnic. Please plan on attending.
5. **Member Assistance Needed** - The Woerner's (Kevin and Michelle), one of our member families had a medical emergency last month. We are planning to have a benefit in connection with our church ice cream social after services on August 30th. We will receive donations for the Woerner's during the month of August. 6. **We have openings for the Fall, 2020 Pre-kindergarten session** September to May. 5 Day AM classes, 4's and 5's (your child must be 4 on or before Sept. 15, 2020.) Sessions run 8:45 am to 11:45 am. Tuition (Our Savior member) \$300.00 monthly. Tuition (non member) 325.00 monthly. Military \$305.00. Enrollment Fee of \$80.00 is required to hold your spot. 12. **Adult Bible Study Orphanage Fund** - For many years now the Sunday morning Bible Study has been supporting an orphanage in Russia. We have committed to send about \$800 every 3 months to buy needed supplies for the orphans. This money doesn't go to the Russians who run the orphanage, but through Orphan Grain Train. It is given to an advocate who purchases the things needed by the orphans and delivers these items directly to the orphanage. We are up to date for the July payment. The balance in the orphanage fund as of July 26 is \$162.45, but we need to bring that up to \$800 by October for our next payment. Please drop something in the orphanage fund container in the narthex regularly so that we can continue this very worthwhile operation. In the past we have raised enough to provide additional money for Christmas gifts etc. for the orphans.

Each Sunday we will be challenged as a congregation to memorize a single verse of Scripture. The verse will come from one of the lessons for the following Sunday and we will recite it together the following Sunday.
