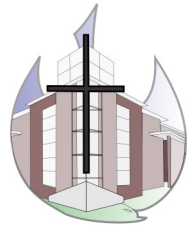

Congregational Announcements

- September is here and that means several things are restarting here at Our Savior.** Sundays will now include normal Sunday morning Bible Study (9/6), Sunday School (9/6), and Confirmation Classes (3-4:30 pm starting 9/13). Wednesday nights will include the 6pm study of the Lutheran Confessions (9/9). Thursday 1:11 will also be starting (9/10) and will be the covering "This coming Sunday" (the same as we were doing on Wednesday nights during the summer). Men's Bible Breakfast (9/10) will be held at 6:30 am at the Church. Please come and learn God's Word from your pastors in these studies.
- We still have a few openings for the Fall, 2020 Pre-kindergarten session** September to May. 5 Day AM classes, 4's and 5's (your child must be 4 on or before Sept. 15, 2020.) Sessions run 8:45 am to 11:45 am. Tuition (Our Savior member) \$300.00 monthly. Tuition (nonmember) 325.00 monthly. Military \$305.00. Enrollment Fee of \$80.00 is required to hold your spot. - Lutheran Faith and Life** - A new session of our adult catechism class will be taught by Pastor Baikie beginning Sunday, September 6, at 9:30 a.m. in the conference room. This class is for anyone who wishes to become a member of Our Savior, along with recent transfers and members who want to review what we Lutherans believe, teach, and confess. Please let Pastor Baikie know if you or someone you know would be interested in attending.
- Confirmation classes will begin in September (Sept 13th, 3-4:30 pm).** Confirmation is a two-year process at Our Savior that begins when both the parents and pastors agree a child is ready to start. Please reach out to the pastors if you think it may be time to get started for your child.
- Days off for our pastors.** A reminder that our pastors each cover a certain day of Friday/Saturday for emergencies. Friday is meant to be Pastor Scheer's day off and Saturday is meant to be Pastor Baikie's day off. This means that if there is an emergency on Friday, call Pastor Baikie. If there is an emergency on Saturday call Pastor Scheer. If there are other non-emergency matters, please speak to them at church or contact them Monday through Thursday (via church office or their phones/emails).
- An Occasion for Celebration** - Pastor Baikie's 10th Anniversary of his ordination into the Holy Ministry - Pastor Baikie was ordained on Sunday, September 12, 2010. We will celebrate his tenth anniversary on Sunday, September 13th in between services. In Ephesians 4, God's Word lists pastors as a gift from God, we are blessed to have Pr. Baikie here with us.
- Adult Bible Study Orphanage Fund** - For many years now the Sunday morning Bible Study has been supporting an orphanage in Russia. We have committed to send about \$800 every 3 months to buy needed supplies for the orphans. This money does not go to the Russians who run the orphanage, but through Orphan Grain Train. It is given to an advocate who purchases the things needed by the orphans and delivers these items directly to the orphanage. We are up to date for the July payment. The balance in the orphanage fund as of September 3 is \$564.53, but we need to bring that up to \$800 by October for our next payment. Please drop something in the orphanage fund container in the narthex regularly so that we can continue this very worthwhile operation. In the past we have raised enough to provide additional money for Christmas gifts etc. for the orphans.
- Esther Hansen (Lois Miller's mom) is turning 100 on September 10!** Join us on Saturday, September 12 at 2:00 pm for a quarantine-style celebration car parade at the Primrose Retirement Community (gather on Dorothy Lane or Powderhouse Rd.).
