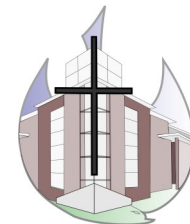


Fourteenth Sunday after Trinity (September 13, 2020)

- Bible Studies** - Please take the time to learn more from the Scriptures. Sunday morning - the Divine Service in the social hall and Lutheran Faith and Life in the Conference room. Wednesdays at 6pm learn the Lutheran Confessions. Thursdays at 1:11 go through the coming Sunday's lessons to help your worship experience. These studies are available via Zoom video conference as well.
- An Occasion for Celebration** - Pastor Baikie's 10th Anniversary of his ordination into the Holy Ministry - Pastor Baikie was ordained on Sunday, September 12, 2010. We will celebrate his tenth anniversary today in between services. In Ephesians 4, God's Word lists pastors as a gift from God, we are blessed to have Pr. Baikie here with us.
- Confirmation classes will begin today from 3-4:30 pm.** Confirmation is a two-year process at Our Savior that begins when both the parents and pastors agree a child is ready to start. Please reach out to the pastors if you think it may be time to get started for your child.
- Y'all come this afternoon** to help with making plastic mats for the homeless. All women are invited. We need help with - cutting the plastic bags, putting the bag strips into round balls, crocheting the plastic strips into a mat for the homeless people. We will meet at 2:00 PM. - We still have a few openings for the Fall,** 2020 Pre-kindergarten session September to May. 5 Day AM classes, 4's and 5's (your child must be 4 on or before Sept. 15, 2020.) Sessions run 8:45 am to 11:45 am. Tuition (Our Savior member) \$300.00 monthly. Tuition (nonmember) 325.00 monthly. Military \$305.00. Enrollment Fee of \$80.00 is required to hold your spot. Parents - The last time we met we had a very helpful discussion on what would help our kids navigate this world as Lutherans and what the congregation can do to help each other on this. Please join us to take up this topic again at the end of the month.
- District Youth Retreat:** Trinity Lutheran Church in Gillette will be hosting a Fall Youth Retreat on October 9-10. Grades 6-12 are invited to join. Cost is \$20 per person (covered by the church), covering dinner (Oct. 9), breakfast, and lunch (Oct 10), snacks, and swimming at the Campbell County Recreation Center. Parents will need to arrange their own transportation. Registration forms and the schedule are available on the round table in the narthex. - Adult Bible Study Orphanage Fund** - For many years now the Sunday morning Bible Study has been supporting an orphanage in Russia. We have committed to send about \$800 every 3 months to buy needed supplies for the orphans. This money does not go to the Russians who run the orphanage, but through Orphan Grain Train. It is given to an advocate who purchases the things needed by the orphans and delivers these items directly to the orphanage. We are up to date for the July payment. The balance in the orphanage fund as of September 10 is \$765.63, but we need to bring that up to \$800 by October for our next payment. Please drop something in the orphanage fund container in the narthex regularly so that we can continue this very worthwhile operation. In the past we have raised enough to provide additional money for Christmas gifts etc. for the orphans.

Each Sunday we will be challenged as a congregation to memorize a single verse of Scripture. The verse will come from one of the lessons for the following Sunday and we will recite it together the following Sunday.
