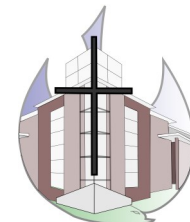


Fifteenth Sunday after Trinity (September 20, 2020)

- Adult Bible Study Orphanage Fund** - For many years now the Sunday morning Bible Study has been supporting an orphanage in Russia. We have committed to send about \$800 every 3 months to buy needed supplies for the orphans. This money does not go to the Russians who run the orphanage, but through Orphan Grain Train. It is given to an advocate who purchases the things needed by the orphans and delivers these items directly to the orphanage. The balance in the orphanage fund as of September 17 is \$1185.63. Please drop something in the orphanage fund container in the narthex regularly so that we can continue this very worthwhile operation. In the past we have raised enough to provide additional money for Christmas gifts etc. for the orphans.
